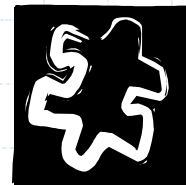
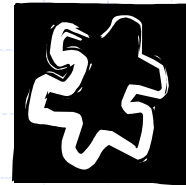
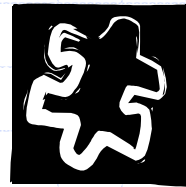
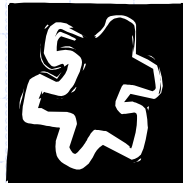
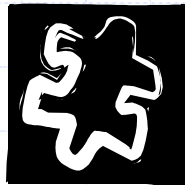


Jigsaw Grouping

Jigsaw is a grouping strategy that allows us to share 3 to 6 pieces of detailed information about a topic or a theme with a group in a short amount of time. It is a team strategy that also encourages cooperative learning, team work and expert sharing. It is appropriate for adult learners and for very young children. The time to be spent in the activity varies on the information to be shared and the sustainability of the participants.

- ◆ **Select 3-6 content articles, videos, or activities to be learned by the overall group.**

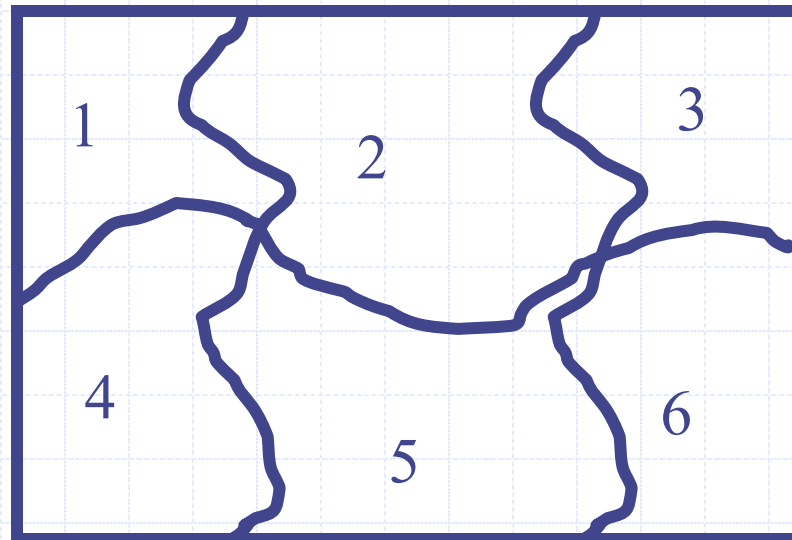

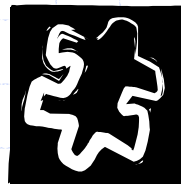
